Evaluation method and schedule: in-class test papers after each course book chapter; oral and written examinations after Level A1 and A2

Requirements for the mid-term checks: During the semester (16 weeks), there will be inclass test papers after each course book chapter and examinations after A1 and A2. Submitting homework, checking it, and discussing mistakes continuously during the semester.

How to create a term grade: The grade for the semester is determined by the average of the in-class papers and examination. If the average of the in-class papers and examination is an insufficient grade, the semester ends with a "Fail" grade. Students may attempt to improve a "Fail" grade according to the Study and Examination Regulations.

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
